- SELF-ASSESSMENT ON CONFLICT MINERALS -

HR 4173, Section 1502, „Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act“, July 2010, “CONFLICT MINERALS”

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

the law H.R. 4173, Section 1502, „Wall Street Reform und Consumer Protection Act“, signed in July 2010 imposes reporting requirements on **publicly-traded** companies manufacturing products that contain metals derived from minerals that originate in the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries. These conflict materials include columbite-tantalite, cassiterite, gold, wolframite or their derivatives.

Please be informed that Murrelektronik as a **non publicly-traded** company is **not** directly subject to this law. To the best of Murrelektronik’s present knowledge, we have no direct suppliers originating in the Democratic Republic of Congo or countries adjacent thereto, nor to the best of Murrelektronik’s present knowledge do any of Murrelektronik’s major suppliers source materials from the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries.

On the basis of the Murrelektronik **LoHS** – List (List of prohibited substances) we claim from our suppliers to deliver no components and/ or materials which contain the specified substances.

The substances of concern, namely «Conflict minerals» (Tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold/ 3TG) are listed.
